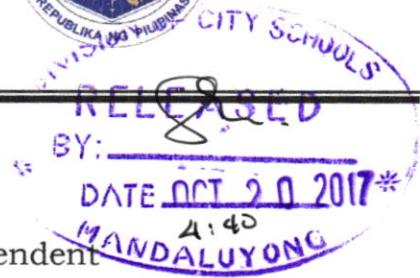

Greetings from the Inclusion Initiative and The Teacher's Gallery, we are the organizations spearheading the campaign for Inclusion in the Philippines! Our campaign for inclusion endeavors to empower educators, legislators, service providers, advocates and civil society organizations to build inclusive communities where all children, regardless of ethnicity, religion, gender, disability, and socio-economic backgrounds, can enter school and finish and contribute to nation building.

The first of these efforts was held last February 22-24, 2017, when it successfully convened the International Leadership Summit in Inclusive Education at the SMX Convention Center Manila. For the first time, over 1,000 stakeholders reached consensus to develop a roadmap to address the challenges children with disabilities face in accessing education.
